

AVAILABLE POSITION: NIGHT PATROL - SECURITY

Summer House Park is a family run business that has been in operation for over 70 years. We have developed a faithful clientele that enjoys our park in part because of the serenity and peacefulness that our natural environment offers. We take pride in offering a quiet and enjoyable family destination for our guests. To ensure that all customers understand and follow our quiet hour policies we have a nighttime staff who patrols our park once our main office is closed. The night patrol employee also helps to assist after hours campers to their site and helps with any other concerns from our guests.

The Night Patrol will be required to understand and enforce our park policies with respect to quiet hours, fire hours, curfews and all other park rules. These policies are in place to ensure that all guests enjoy our park and remain respectful to fellow campers. Night Patrol must conduct themselves in a respectful and mature manner at all times and to treat guests with respect and dignity. Night patrol is also responsible for the security of all park buildings as well as to ensure park grounds, as well as washrooms and other buildings meet our standards of cleanliness. This position requires flexibility to meet ever-changing demands or requests.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform Summer House Park duties with regards to rules and regulation enforcement.
- Required to perform all building maintenance and cleaning of all washroom buildings.
- Ensure all buildings are secure and locked if necessary.
- Ensure that playground, beach and any common areas are closed after hours.
- Maintain campground cleanliness.
- Ensure quiet hours and nighttime policies are followed.
- Assist after hours arrivals.
- Observe for extra cars and camping units (such as extra tents) on sites.
- Perform duties at the maintenance manager or campground owner's request.

Behavioral Skills:

Night Patrol workers are in direct contact with our visiting tourists, therefore appearance, conduct and strong language skills are essential. Employees will execute the job responsibilities in a motivated, efficient and professional manner.

Physical Requirements:

This position requires walking and use of a golf cart.

Dress Code:

This position requires athletic footwear and a uniform jacket.

Hours: Full time, 7:00 pm to 1:00 am during summer months; shorter hours and weekends, spring and fall.
